


# Space Practice


Follow the space crafts and practice just like Andromeda did. Maybe someday you'll be in the Symphony too!




1  
Play line one. Make sure (P) half notes get two beats. (Are slower)




2  
Play line one and two. Check bowing pattern. (Long, Short, Short)

Play line three (5 times)




4  
Play line three (2 times) Make sure you check the dynamics.

Play piece. Check last measure in line two and four. The half notes get two beats (P). The rest (■) gets 2 beats.

Play piece. Pay close attention to dynamics.

Play piece. Make sure you lift your bow at the rest ■.
